Closure:

Governor Wolf has closed all PA schools indefinitely. This means that all athletics, extra-curricular activities and community use of District facilities are canceled until schools are permitted to reopen. We will monitor the Governor's direction and provide updates when additional information is released.

- April 13, is an online instruction day. This date was previously designated as a snow make-up day.
- WASD is scheduled to end the 2019-20 school year on June 5, 2020.
