Courses for credit

- Summer Institute courses are considered Option II. Each course/grade is recorded on the transcript but not included in a student's GPA.
- Intensive summer study...in addition to completing all classwork students will be required to complete assigned homework. This will include studying for tests, practice problems, textbook reading and the preparation of lab reports and/or assignments.
- Final grade reports at conclusion of program.
- Course changes that result in course work will be resolved at the conclusion of classes.

Attendance Policy

Attendance during the Summer Institute carries the same weight as it does during the school year. A full year course (6 week) permits two days of absence; a semester course (3 week) permits one day.

Personal Financial Management- *online*

- Runs from June 28th to July 23rd.
- Daily coursework is expected to be 3 hours a day of work
- 2 required hours of synchronous zoom sessions (1 Monday & 1 Wednesday between 9am -10am or 12pm -1pm). Students are required to log into one of the zoom sessions for an hour during the assigned time.
- A mandatory student orientation session will take place in June.
- In person final exam on 7/21/22 at 9am
