Empowering Parents Grant for Idaho Families

- Empowering Parents is a state of Idaho program funded by federal Coronavirus Relief funds.
- It provides Idaho school aged students access to funds that can be used to purchase educational goods and services, directly controlled by families.
- If you are a parent or guardian of an Idaho student(s) you can apply for these funds.
- Eligible families can:
 - o Receive a credit for \$1000 per child up to \$3000 per family to be used on the Primary Class online marketplace.
 - o Once the account is created and eligibility verified, monies are deposited into a digital wallet and are available to be spent over a 24-month period.

- Eligible purchases include computers and technology, paying for internet, instructional materials, fees for courses, tutoring services, educational services, and therapies through approved vendors in the online marketplace.
- The application window is now open.
