Course Structure

- All units must be completed by 1:00pm on Wednesday, July 12th. **Coursework may be completed early.** Students must attend eight 90 minute classes. All coursework not completed in class **must be completed at home** or in the computer lab on Fridays.
- **A computer lab will be available during school hours on each Friday of summer school**
- This course will be delivered entirely online through Odysseyware. In this course, you will access online lessons designed to teach the concepts for that unit. The online Health course includes 7 units with 10-15 lessons, 2-3 projects, and 2-3 quizzes each. Every unit concludes with a comprehensive test. **Typically, the course requires 45-60 hours of total work.**
- Each lesson concludes with a set of review questions that the students must answer. Each set of review questions must be passed (70%) before moving on to the next lesson.
- A comprehensive test completes several of the units.
 - Unit tests **must be taken in the computer classroom/lab** with supervision
 - Students can contact instructor to have tests “zeroed out” to move on to the next unit
- **Lessons/Quizzes/Tests** – a passing score is required to move to next lesson
 - **Lessons** must be passed with a minimum 70% score – maximum retakes: 10
 - **Quizzes** must be passed with a minimum 70% score – maximum retakes: 5
 - **Unit tests CANNOT** be retaken. They can only be taken **ONCE**. Your score is recorded after your first attempt and you are advanced to the next unit. **USE YOUR NOTES!!**
- **It is your responsibility to maintain a pace that will complete the course on time.**

Attendance

Summer attendance policies will be strictly enforced

Students may not miss more than 3 hours of in class “seat time” (2 class meetings)

A full day absence counts as 90 minutes – any tardies count in increments of 15 minutes

Pacing (10%)

- To receive this 10% - Unit 3 must be completed by 5:00pm on Tuesday, June 25th
- **Students who fall behind the recommended pace are in DANGER OF FAILING**
- All unit lessons, quizzes, and tests must be completed by 1:00pm on Wed, July 12th
- The Odysseyware dashboard offers a **SUGGESTED** pacing guide to help prevent you from falling behind.
- Students who have not completed Unit 5 by Mon, July 8th **WILL BE DROPPED FROM THE COURSE.**

To receive this 10% - Unit 3 must be completed by 5:00pm on Tuesday, June 25th.

Notebook (15%)

Students must maintain a handwritten course notebook that outlines each lesson

- Students must use a college ruled composition notebook.
- Heading on each page: **Student name, ID#, Unit#** and **Lesson#** and **lesson title**
- **Notebooks must be digitally uploaded to CANVAS for full credit (not uploaded: -2 pts.)**
- **Notebooks must be uploaded to CANVAS BEFORE students can take the unit tests.**
- The notebook *can and should* be used when taking lesson reviews, quizzes, and unit tests.

Expectations

This course is **self-paced** and requires as much as **10-15 hours per week** to be completed successfully. Therefore, to ensure success, students:

1. Must sign up for "Remind 101" to receive texts regarding class updates (see top of p.1)
2. **Must use REMIND** to communicate any concerns or difficulties to the teacher immediately.
3. Understand that all summer school attendance and behavior rules will be enforced.
4. Will arrive on time and be prepared to work for each of the 8 class meetings.
5. Shall be respectful and careful with all computer equipment in the lab.
6. May use the computers for class assignments only.
7. May not bring their own software programs, USB drives, or other outside devices.
8. Will log in to the Odysseyware website **ONLY** – no other internet sites are allowed.
9. Must alert the teacher of any signs of vandalism or damage at their computer station.
10. **Are expected to do their own work. Any sharing of files, assignments, quiz/test questions is considered cheating.**
11. **Any violation of academic honesty will result in removal from the class.**

Other Class Rules

- Be polite and respectful to the teacher and classmates.
- No food or drinks are allowed in the computer lab. Closed water bottles are okay.
- **Students may not use cell phones, ipods, or other electronic devices during class.**
- No hats or beanies should be worn inside the classroom.
- Purses and backpacks should be stored beneath the desk.
