

## BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

### Raleigh County Schools

Tuesday, November 28, 2017

**ROLL CALL** – The Raleigh County Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, November 28, 2017 at 4:30 PM at Stratton Elementary School with the following members present: President Larry D. Ford, Vice-President Jack G. Roop, Dr. Charlotte Hutchens, Ms. Marie Hamrick, Ms. Marsha K. Smith, and Mr. C. David Price, Secretary.

### **CALL TO ORDER**

President Ford called the meeting to order.

### **APPROVAL OF AGENDA/ADJUSTMENTS**

Mr. Roop made the motion to approve the agenda. Ms. Smith seconded it. Motion passed 5-0.

### **DELEGATIONS**

  - John Quesenberry, Social Studies Teacher at Woodrow Wilson High School, informed board members of State Policy 2510 which is on comment through December 11<sup>th</sup>, changing social studies credits from 4 to 3. Mr. Quesenberry urged board members to oppose this action but, if passed, to continue four years of social studies within Raleigh County.

- Approve revision of Cooperation with Law Enforcement Agencies Policy D.3.14 (cross-filed as F.14)

- Approve student teaching agreement with Western Governors University  
 Upon explanation of the agreement by Human Resources Director Anthony Jones and board discussion, Ms. Smith made the motion to table this action until the next meeting. Ms. Hamrick seconded it. Motion passed 5-0.
- Approve school colors and mascot for Ridgeview Elementary School  
 Dr. Starcher informed the board that, with involvement and input of students, the wolf was selected as Ridgeview Elementary School's mascot with colors being sky blue, silver, and white.  
 Dr. Hutchens made the motion to approve the selections. Ms. Smith seconded it. Motion passed 5-0.
