

## **BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING**

### **Raleigh County Schools**

Tuesday, October 27, 2020

**ROLL CALL** – The Raleigh County Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, October 27, 2020 at 5:30 PM in Munson Hall at the Raleigh County Schools Central Office with the following members present: President Larry D. Ford, Vice President Jack G. Roop, Dr. Charlotte Hutchens, Ms. Marie Hamrick, Mr. Richard V. Snuffer II, and Mr. C. David Price, Secretary.

### **CALL TO ORDER**

President Ford called the meeting to order.

### **APPROVAL OF AGENDA/ADJUSTMENTS**

President Ford requested approval of the agenda. Mr. Snuffer made the motion to approve. Dr. Hutchens seconded it. Motion passed 5-0.

**RECOGNITIONS** – There were no recognitions.

### **DELEGATIONS**

  - 1) Lisa Meadows, parent of split household, voiced her concerns regarding children not returning to classroom five days a week.
  - 2) Terry Hamrick provided information regarding Covid-19 and children.
  - 3) Linda Boyd, President of AFT, requested teachers continue on the blended model.
  - 4) Brooke Robinson, parent, addressed her concerns of not being able to assist with math homework.
  - 5) Tyler Robinson, parent, expressed his concern for children's health and safety during Covid-19.
  - 6) Amanda Wiles, parent of student in special programs, feels her child is not receiving the amount of instruction necessary.

  - Melissa Fox with Virtual Programs, updated board members on virtual school requirements and informed them Raleigh County currently has 957 elementary, 497 middle and 550 high school students enrolled in virtual schools.
  - Treasurer/CSBO Darrin Butcher presented the Annual Excess Levy Report.

- Consider canceling the 2<sup>nd</sup> Regular Meeting of November  
Mr. Snuffer made the motion to reschedule and move the 2<sup>nd</sup> regular meeting to Monday, November 30, 2020 at 5:30 PM. Mr. Roop seconded it. Motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Snuffer made the motion to continue on the blended model through December 4. Mr. Roop seconded it. Motion passed 5-0.
