The Orion Education Association (OEA) Scholarship is a one year, nonrenewable award of \$750. This scholarship is offered to one Orion High School senior student who will enroll in a college or university and major in an education or an education related field. The scholarship is payable upon receipt of proof of enrollment in a college or university program. This scholarship is funded by donations made by Orion School District Employees.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Must be a senior graduating from Orion High School.
2. Must be enrolled in a college or university education or education related degree program. The eligible programs include: teacher, librarian, instructional media specialist, school nurse, school counselor, school psychologist, school social worker or any others which require certification from the State Board of Education.
3. Must be in the upper half of the senior class.
4. Should exhibit good citizenship, industriousness, leadership and dependability.

COMPONENTS:

1. Release page.
2. Student Statement-write a brief statement expressing why you plan to pursue a degree in an education or education related field. The statement may be handwritten or typed.
3. Educator's Recommendation. Have a teacher or someone in the field of education to write you a recommendation telling why he/she feels you should receive this scholarship.
4. Activities sheet.
