

McCain Family Scholarship Application

The McCain Family Scholarship is a competitive, full-tuition, four year scholarship to The College of Idaho in Caldwell, Idaho. Two scholarships are available annually, one awarded to a Payette High School senior, the other to a senior attending a public rural school in the Treasure Valley. Applicants must possess a G.P.A. of at least 3.25 and have been accepted to The College of Idaho. Applicants demonstrating financial need will receive priority consideration.

Recipients of the scholarship will be expected to complete their degree within four consecutive years while maintaining a semester G.P.A. of at least 3.00. All credits counting toward the scholar's G.P.A. must be earned through The College of Idaho. Credits from other colleges will not be accepted toward this requirement.

Scholarship applicants must have applied to, and been accepted by, The College of Idaho.

Applications must include:

- Completed application form (Attached)
- List of all work, volunteer, and extra-curricular activities
- List of special awards/commendations
- Most recent academic transcript
- Essay
- Sealed, completed financial statement. (See attached) Note: The financial statement will be viewed only by a member or representative of the McCain family. Falsification of any information on the form will result in the immediate disqualification or revocation of the scholarship.
- Three letters of recommendation: two from members of staff/faculty of applicant's school and one from a non-family member of the community in which the applicant resides.

History of the McCain Family scholarship

Warren E. and Bernie McCain

Bernie Jenkins and Warren McCain were both educated in Payette, Idaho. In spite of a disadvantaged background and lacking a college degree, Warren rose from the rank of box boy to become President and CEO of Albertson's, Inc. He always credited his success in life to his supportive wife, Bernie, and to his wonderful teachers in Payette.

To honor these teachers, in the 1980's Bernie and Warren established at Payette High School two full-tuition scholarships at the College of Idaho, to be awarded annually. In 2019 the scholarships were revised, opening one of them to students in rural counties of the Treasure Valley.

Should questions arise regarding information contained in the financial statement, the McCain Family representative may share the information with a representative of the College of Idaho's Office of Financial Aid. Any misrepresentation or falsification of information contained in the financial aid form will result in immediate disqualification of the applicant or revocation of the scholarship.
