1:1 CHROMEBOOK INFORMATION GRADES 6-12 STUDENTS ONLY

This fall we will continue our 1:1 Chromebook distribution for students in grades 6-12. All students in grades 6-12 will be issued a school owned Chromebook for the school year. Students will be required to have their Chromebook at school each day and have the option to bring it home to complete work outside of the school day.

This is a great option to enhance teaching and student learning but comes with a great responsibility. Students will have their own Chromebook that is checked out to them similar to a library book. Students will be responsible to care for and charge the Chromebook so that they are available for use all day, every day during instruction.

Each year, families have the option to participate in the school offered [protection plan](#). This plan covers the cost of any incidental damage that may occur. Those families that do not participate in the protection plan will be charged for any damaged or lost devices. The protection plan is **\$25 per student with a family maximum of \$75**. The protection plan is for one year and families will have the opportunity to participate each year.

The intent is to distribute Chromebooks to all students before the start of the school year. Students and families can pick up their Chromebooks during open house on Wednesday, August 31 from 4:00 until 7:00. Pickup will take place in the HS-MS Classic Gym. **The attached paperwork will need to be completed before a device is checked out that evening.** Chromebooks and class schedules will be organized by grade level tables in the gym. Any students or families that are unable to pick up at that time can contact the HS-MS office to determine a plan for distribution.

CHROMEBOOK PROGRAM PARENT AGREEMENT FORM GRADES 6-12 ONLY

Technology in Luverne School District has been integrated to help prepare students in a rapidly changing world. Students' proper use of technology is a valued resource to our community. All electronic technologies must be used to support the educational programs in the district. Access to the District's technology may be revoked at any time for abusive or inappropriate conduct related to the use of digital technologies

Failure to comply with the District's Internet/Technology Acceptable Use Policy (524), Bullying Prohibition Policy (514), or guidelines stated in the Digital Learning Handbook may result in the loss or privilege to use the Chromebook.

The devices are the property of Luverne Public Schools and as a result may be seized and reviewed at any time. The students should have NO expectation of privacy of materials found on a school owned device. Individual school devices, cases, and accessories must be returned at the end of the school year. Students who withdraw, are expelled, or terminate enrollment at ISD 2184 for any reason must return their individual school device and accessories on the date of termination.

If a student fails to return the device at the end of the school year or upon termination of enrollment in ISD 2184, that student will be subject to criminal prosecution or civil liability. The student will be required to pay the replacement cost of the device. Failure to return the device will result in a theft report filing with the Sherriff's Department.

Please complete the bottom portion of the agreement for all students that will be in grades 6-12.

A protection plan is available for all District issued devices. The protection plan will cover the school year, from the date of inspection until the end of the school year or the day the device is returned. **The annual cost of the protection plan is \$25 per device per year, with a family limit of \$75.** It is highly recommended that families take part in the Chromebook protection plan. In the event that families chose NOT to participate they will be liable for all damage and the cost of all repairs.
