Dear Parents:

Please take note of the following important information:

- **Enrollment choice for second semester:** Please make sure you register your selection for school choice by going to the Kanawha County Schools website @ kcs.kana.k12.wv.us and scrolling down the home page until you see "Enrollment Selection." You can click the link to the form and follow the directions. It is important that you fill out the form, even if your child is continuing with his/her current method of learning. Please complete the form ASAP so we can make plans for the upcoming semester. If you have any questions or cannot access the form, please call the office.
- **Messages from school:** School information will be added to Schoology. Please check Schoology for monthly calendars, special activities, newsletters and other information. We are no longer using Remind for messages.
- **Email addresses:** All parents receive phone messages regularly from Kanawha County Schools to keep you informed about the WVDE color coded map. Weberwood will be setting up school messages through email. Many of you included your email address on the emergency card you filled out at the beginning of the school year. If your teacher does not have your email address, please send it to her. We will compile a list of all email addresses for the school so we can send out messages as needed. This would be the least disruptive way to communicate information to our parents/guardians.
- **Students:** I am so proud of the way our in-person students have been learning and handling the safety precautions we are taking at school. Wearing masks has become their "way of life" and they keep them on throughout the entire school day with no complaints. They wash their hands and use hand sanitizer frequently and keep their distance from others in the classroom. Our e-learners are attending live learning sessions daily with their teacher and are progressing very well with this mode of learning.
- **Student after school pick up:** When you are picking your child up from school on the parking lot, please do not arrive at school any earlier than 1:50. We don't want to block the traffic lane so buses and other vehicles cannot get through. Thank you for your cooperation.
- **Food distribution:** As you know, the county has been providing breakfast and lunch for students learning from home and for other students during our "out of school" days. **On Thursday, November 19th, the school bus will deliver food boxes on their normal bus routes and on Friday, November 20th, all of the "in person" students will be taking a box of food and milk home with them from school. Please meet your child at the bus stop to help them carry the food and milk.**
- **Remote learning:** The Governor has notified us that there will be no in person learning on November 30, December 1st and December 2nd. The students will all be learning remotely from home for those days. In-person learning will resume on December 3rd.
