Dear Parents/Guardians:

As of today, November 12, 2021, our district has a total of fifty-two (52) positive COVID-19 cases. There are twenty-six (26) positive cases at Golden Brook School, eighteen (18) positive cases at Windham Center School, four (4) positive cases at Windham Middle School, and four (4) positive cases at Windham High School. Our district continues to see an increase in positive cases being reported each day. Due to the rapid rise in cases, two of our four schools have been placed on an indoor mask mandate. Our leadership team is in ongoing communication with NH DHHS and our public health consultant, and we will continue to make the best and safest decision for the whole school community.

Please continue to conduct a health and symptom check on your child every morning before school. If your child is experiencing **any symptoms**, please keep them home and seek testing. If your child tests positive for COVID-19 from an at-home or rapid test they should not attend school and these results should be considered an accurate representation of a positive test result. Our district is dedicated to providing quality education to our students amidst this ongoing pandemic. The district is currently offering Safer at School Screenings (SASS) at each school, we will be hosting a voluntary student vaccination clinic on Friday, November 19th, and we are working with our local fire department to provide our staff with the opportunity to receive their booster shot.

Outside of COVID-19 reporting, below are some additional items that I wanted to share with you:

- **Veterans:** We would like to take a moment to recognize and thank our veterans that are currently employed in our schools. We thank them for their service to our country and their continued service to our students.
- **Student Vaccination Clinic:** You should have received the registration information for our voluntary student vaccination clinic. Please check your email for the details. We are aware that some people may be having issues registering. We are currently troubleshooting with the state and we will update you with any information we receive.
