Dear Parents/Guardians:

As of today, December 3, 2021, our district has a total of fifty-six (56) positive COVID-19 cases. There are thirty-two (32) positive cases at Golden Brook School, eight (8) positive cases at Windham Center School, six (6) positive cases at Windham Middle School, and ten (10) positive cases at Windham High School. We have seen an increase in cases reported since the holiday weekend. Based on the criteria within the indoor mask matrix, Golden Brook School and Windham Center School were placed on indoor mask mandates for ten consecutive days. Please continue to conduct a health and symptom check on your child every morning before school. If your child is experiencing **any symptoms**, please keep them home and seek testing.

Outside of the ongoing surveillance of the COVID-19 pandemic, below are a few additional items that I wanted to make you aware of.

- **Registration for the Second COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Now Open!:** Please follow the instructions provided to make your appointment. Registration will only accept students who participated in our first clinic. Walk-in appointments will not be available. If you were not able to secure an appointment for our first clinic, you can contact your child's pediatrician directly or visit www.vaccines.gov to find a location providing COVID-19 vaccines near you.
- **Statue at Golden Brook/Middle School Campus:** The class of 2018 has donated funds to have a statue placed on the Golden Brook/Middle School campus that was installed this week. The statue is based on the famous poem by Robert Frost, "The Road Not Taken".
