District COVID-19 Case Count: As of Friday, April 1, our district had a total of four (4) positive COVID-19 cases. There are two (2) positive cases at Golden Brook School, zero (0) positive cases at Windham Center School, zero (0) positive cases at Windham Middle School, and two (2) positive cases at Windham High School.
