Dear Parents/Guardians,

During this time of continuing economic uncertainty, San Diego Unified School District must continue to pursue every potential source of funding to support our important work of preparing our students for success.

Impact Aid Funds are designated to assist school districts that lose tax revenue due to their enrollment of students from families who live or work on tax-exempt federal properties or are active-duty military personnel. Our schools are heavily impacted with federally connected students.

Impact Aid funds become part of the school system's general operating budget and support instructional activities for **all students**.

To qualify for Impact Aid funding, the U.S. Department of Education requires us to survey each student to determine eligibility. Therefore, we ask **all parents** to complete the attached survey form to help us qualify.

To assist you:

- We have preprinted the student information on the survey form.
- If correct, please sign/date the form and return it as soon as possible.
- If correction is needed, please cross out any incorrect information, and make the correction in the space allotted. Please initial correction.
- Please make sure all boxes are completed in full detail (employer, branch, division, city, state, zip, etc.)
- **Employer** is not the same as the **Federal property** (see example below)
 - Work at Panda Express (Employer) on 32nd St. Naval Base (Federal Property)
- For parents/guardians on Active Duty, please include Branch of Service and Rank. If you are in the **Reserves or National Guard** and mobilized under federal orders, please attach a copy of your orders to the form. You may black out PIV (personally identifiable information).

Your cooperation in returning completed forms promptly will be greatly appreciated. The more forms returned, the greater the amount of funds available to our school system. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact Pat McCoy 619-725-7593.
