2. SSC Business..... (5 minutes) ➤ Approval of Minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Action Item: Approval of Minutes from January 13, 2015 	<p><u>Action:</u> Minutes were unanimously approved. 1st motion: Dr. Roberson; 2nd motion: Ms. Fulton</p>
3. 2015-16 Budget Review - Priorities.....(20 Minutes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dr. Roberson 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dr. Roberson reports that the district will release the school's budget on Feb. 26 and the school will return the completed budget to the district on March 9. SSC discussed how Title I funds are currently used to fund the ELST position. The SSC discussed that Title I funds are categorical funds which must be allocated to support 'at risk' students; the designation 'at risk' was discussed. Using this criteria, it was determined that approximately one third of our students might be described as 'at risk' because of their GPAs. The work of the ELST was described by Mr. Kunkel. The work of the Intervention Team was described by Mr. Altomare. <p><u>Action:</u> The SSC voted unanimously to continue to fund the ELST position. 1st motion: Ms. Milo; 2nd motion: Ms. Fulton</p>

The SSC discussed how best to publicize the safety of the campus and community. <p>Action The SSC voted unanimously to approve the Comprehensive School Safety Plan 1st motion: Dr. Roberson; 2nd motion: Ms. Fulton</p>
6. ELAC/DELAC Report(15 Minutes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr. Kunkel 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr. Kunkel reported the following: The ELAC meets tonight at 6 pm. And CELDT scores are now available in the school's student information system (Powerschool).
7. Public Comment.....(5 minutes)		<p>The SSC discussed the parents' and community's questions and concerns about the transition to a school including career pathways. Parents have shared concerns that 8th and 9th graders are being asked to decide upon a career at such a young age. Other parents have shared concerns that there might be an isolation of students similar to what is experienced by students at the small schools at Kearny or San Diego High.</p> <p>It was recommended that the ASB work to improve student involvement in the campus activities and to generate additional activities for the students. I was also recommended that the school engage in better community relations and develop more activities for the community to visit the school.</p>
