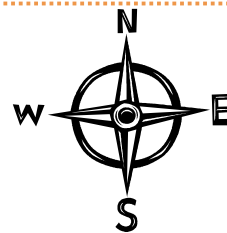

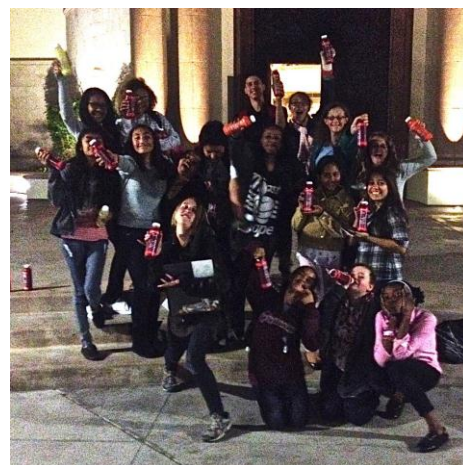

GIRLS, After School Club

GIRLS is an after school club designed to challenge societal norms while promoting informed discussion and change amongst its members, the school, and the community. In its second year, GIRLS stands for Girls and boys Impacting and Realizing Liberation in Society. GIRLS is dedicated to understanding and advocating gender equity through research, dialogue, social media, and student leadership. GIRLS activities include weekly meetings, documentary screenings, social media involvement, feminist discourse, discussions on gender-related current events, trips to USD's Institute of Peace and Justice, WorldLink's Youth Town Hall Meeting, and lectures from Women Peacemakers. Upcoming activities and events planned include a collaborative effort with Me2We to hold a documentary screening and discussion for students and parents at the school.

Our most recent event was a March 4th trip to USD for a screening and panel discussion of the film, Honor Diaries, which addresses the basic human rights abuses women and girls endure.
