“MAGI Medi-Cal”? “Medi-Cal Expansion”? How do I know if I qualify for Medi-Cal?

To be eligible for Medi-Cal before January 1st, 2014 you had to be:

- Making less than \$15,522 per year (133% Federal Poverty Level)
- Be over the age of 65
- Pregnant or have children living at home
- Have a documented disability
- Pass the “asset test”

To qualify for Medi-Cal right now under the new guidelines of MAGI Medi-Cal or Medi-Cal Expansion that went into effect January 1st, 2014:

- You must make less than \$16,105 per year (138% of the Federal Poverty Level)

NOTE:

If you have limited Medi-Cal or a share-of-cost based on the old eligibility guidelines, you are free to request a “redetermination” of benefits.

Enrollment is ongoing!
