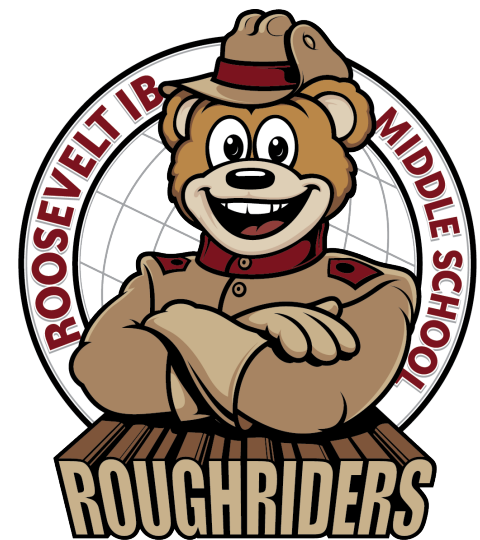

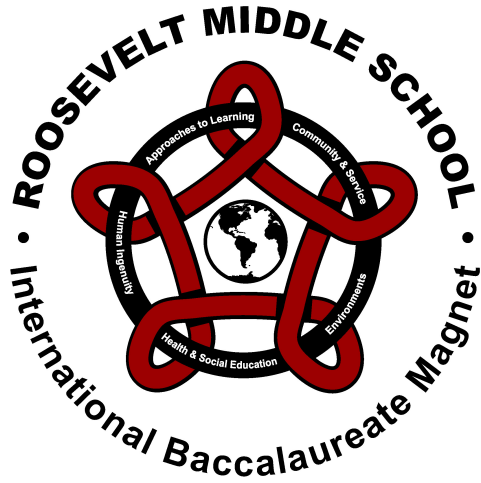

What is ELAC?

The purpose of ELAC is to advise the principal and the staff on programs and services for English learners.

Each school with 21 or more English learners in attendance, regardless of language, must form a functioning ELAC in accordance with Section 52176 and 62002.5 of the Education Code.

ELAC should be predominantly made up of parents of English learners and, as a minimum, the Committee should reflect the percentage of English learners at the school.

There is no minimum size for the Committee.

Responsibilities of ELAC:

Review, comment and advise the principal and staff on at least the following:

Parent involvement matters! Hundreds of studies show that when parents get involved, children do better at school.

- The development of a detailed master plan for English learner education and supplementary services provided to English learners
- The development of a School Needs Assessment.
- Formulate ways to make parents aware of the importance of regular attendance.
