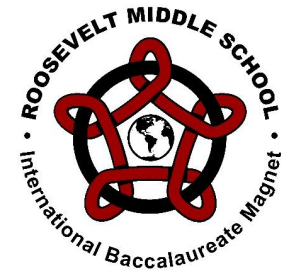

# TITLE I

## WHAT IS TITLE I

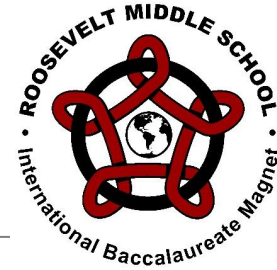
- ❖ Provides additional academic support and learning opportunities for students at schools with high percentages of socioeconomically disadvantaged children.
- ❖ Intended to help ensure that all students meet state academic standards.

## GOALS OF TITLE I

- ❖ Increase academic achievement
- ❖ Provide direct instructional support to students
- ❖ Provide professional development for teachers
- ❖ Promote parent education and involvement

# Parent Rights

---



- ❖ Ask for meetings and trainings.
- ❖ Review the school's achievement data.
- ❖ Review the parent involvement plan in the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA).
- ❖ Review and modify the site Title I Parent Involvement Policy and Home/School Compact.

# Parent Involvement



- ❖ The School Site Council (SSC) provides parents with an opportunity to be involved in the academic program of the school.
- ❖ SSC meetings are held once a month - 10/21, 11/18, 1/27, 2/10, 3/17, 4/14, 5/12

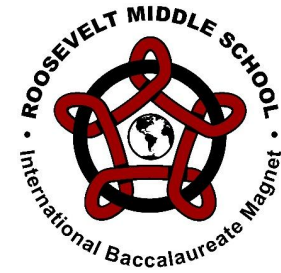

# School Plan for Student Achievement “SPSA”

- ❖ The SPSA is a school’s framework for continued improvement that outlines a school’s goals, strategies and supports for student achievement.
- ❖ All school’s SPSAs are public documents and can be found online on the District’s Website.
- ❖ Goal Areas:
  - Safe, Collaborative and Inclusive Culture
  - English Language Arts
  - Math
  - English Learners
  - Students with Disabilities
  - Black Youth
  - Family Engagement
  - Graduation/Promotion Rate



# Title I Funds



- ❖ Schools are allocated Title I funds on the basis of the percentage of students eligible (at least 40%) for free/reduced lunch. (Roosevelt = 63% FRL)
- ❖ One percent (1%) of a school's total Title I budget is for parent involvement activities (Resource 30103).
- ❖ Funds must supplement, not supplant, district funds.

Every Title I school, in collaboration with parents, **MUST** prepare a site level Parent Involvement Policy and Home/School Compact

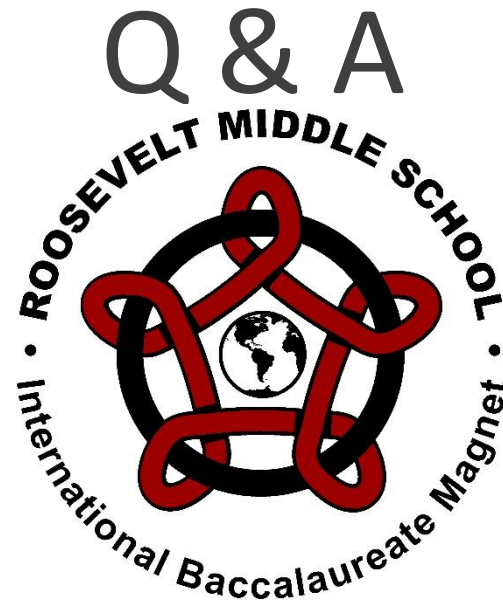

- ❖ The Home/School Compact component describes the responsibilities of the school, the parent, and the student for improved student achievement.
