## Reading

Kids should be reading every night. Make it a routine and read yourself. Talk to them about their book. Ask them to change the story by using a different setting or problem. ## Math

Learn the times tables. Use card games like 'WAR', multiply the two numbers together correctly to win the point. Practice counting by 3's, 4's, 6's, 7's, 8's, and 9's.

Review your 3<sup>rd</sup> grade math books. Addition with carrying and subtraction with borrowing are easily forgotten.

## Writing

Take turns writing a story. You start, then your student takes over, then it's your turn again. Keep taking turns until you have a great story to share with your family and friends.

Have your kids write a complete sentence, with capitals and periods, anytime they want to ask a question or tattle on each other. (This may be for you actually). Have a journal for them to write their tattles. Remind them to use proper grammar and punctuation.
