
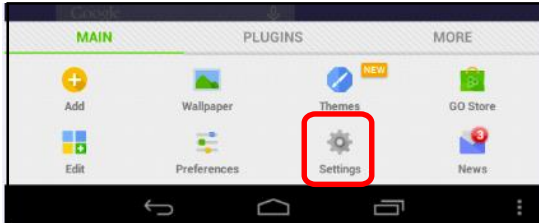




Adding Chrome to Your Home Screen for Y4 Android Devices

Adding the App to Your Home Screen

1. From the home screen, tap the additional options icon  in the lower right corner.
2. Tap “Settings” icon. (This is located under the Main tab)

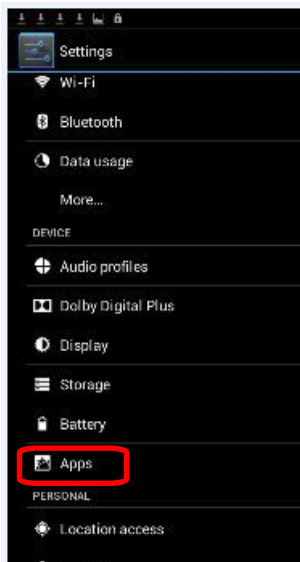


3. You will be prompted to enter a password at this time. Enter “4100.”

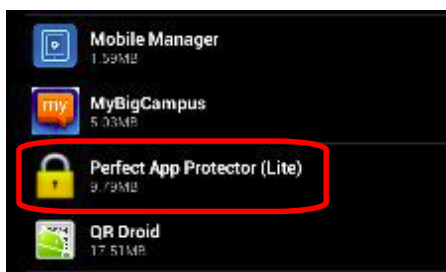


Important Note: This password is for teacher information only. Under **no** circumstances should it be shared with students.

4. Find and Tap **Apps** in the list of Settings.



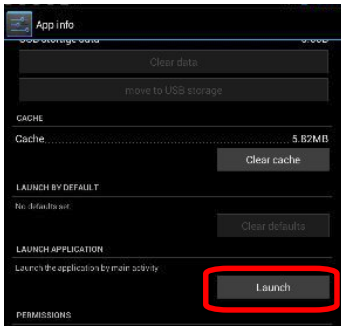
6. Locate and tap on the “Perfect App Protector (Lite).”





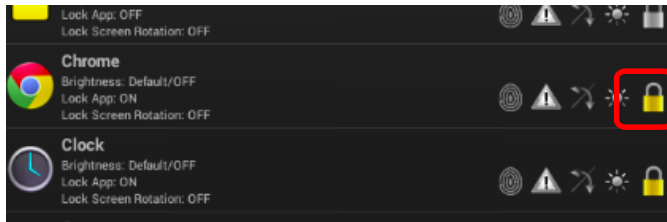

7. **“Launch”** this Application. You will be prompted to enter the password again. Enter **“4100.”**



NOTE: If you get a pop-up box asking you to update version, hit **Cancel**.

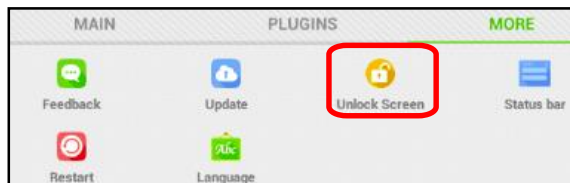
8. Find Chrome in the list of Apps. You will want to tap the gold lock to the right to unlock this App. You know you have unlocked it if the gold lock turns to a silver lock.



9. Tap the **Home**  icon.

10. Tap the additional options icon 

11. Tap **“More”** tab. Then tap **“Unlock Screen”**



12. You will now be back on the Android desktop. Tap to open the **“Apps”** folder. Then tap the **“+”** sign (top, right-hand corner.)

13. Find **Chrome**. Tap so it has a **check-mark** next to its name. Then hit **“OK.”**



14. Chrome will appear in your Apps folder. **Press and hold** the Chrome icon and **drag** it onto desktop.



Note: It is recommended to keep the android desktops the same, so wherever you place the Chrome app on one android, be sure to place it in the same place on the other androids.
