



POLICY SECTION 1011/606: Reporting Student Progress

POLICY

The Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education believes that student progress must be regularly and formally reported to parents/guardians during the school year. Two methods of reporting have been approved. Student Report Cards, and Parent/Guardian Teacher Conferences. It is recognized that in certain circumstances, more frequent communications between the school and parents/guardian are needed. In these cases the school should communicate with parents/guardians as the need arises rather than waiting for formal reporting periods.

GUIDELINES

1. School administration and staff are responsible for the development of appropriate report cards in consultation with the Director of Education and the community. The Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education shall approve the report card format and grading system.
2. Report cards will be issued a minimum of three times a year for students, including the final report.

Note: The Director of Education in consultation with school administration will set specific report card dates at the time the school calendar is developed each year.

3. Parent/Guardian Teacher Conferences shall be conducted a minimum of two times a year. Report cards shall be given out during the Parent/Guardian Teacher Conference.
