



POLICY SECTION 1023: Student Vehicles

POLICY

The Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education believes that as a safety precaution, students are not allowed to use motorized vehicles at the school during school hours.

GUIDELINES

1. Students, under the age of 16, may not bring a motor vehicle to school because they are not yet old enough to have a license.
2. Staff members shall not lend their vehicles to any student when the school is open for students on a regular school day.
3. The Principal may give special permission to students 16 years of age and over to bring a vehicle to school when the student must remain at the school after regular hours for specific student activities when no school bus will be available.
4. The Principal may designate a parking space for student vehicles if students in his/her respective school are legally of age to drive. Students failing to park their vehicles in the designated area shall have their privileges to bring a vehicle to school terminated.
