POLICY SECTION 1110: Services for Students Attending Provincial Schools

POLICY

The Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education believes that it must ensure that appropriate special education services and programs are provided for those students attending provincial schools. Students who have been identified as requiring special services in our primary and intermediate schools should be able to transition into programs in provincial schools that meet their individual needs.

GUIDELINES

- 1. The Board will ensure that provisions for special education programs and services are included within its education services agreements with provincial school boards.
- 2. Additional costs for services will only arise if the provincial school does not offer the program or service to any other enrolled student.
- 3. The Board will ensure that appropriate programs and services for its students are available at the provincial schools the students will be attending.
- 4. The Board will request an annual report from the provincial school(s) listing the students receiving special services and an outline of the services provided.
- 5. Support staff members employed by the Board assigned to work at the secondary school level will monitor the services provided to special needs students to facilitate school-to-independent living transitions.
