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## **POLICY SECTION 219: Board Committees and Sub-Committees**

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### **POLICY**

The Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education believes that it may be beneficial to establish committees and sub-committees of the Board. Committees and Sub-Committees may allow the Board to study aspects of education in more detail, may save time and expenses for certain projects, or allow for better communication and control during some activities. The Board, however, believes that the Board as a group must approve all proposed actions of the committees and sub-committees.

### **GUIDELINES**

The Board may create two types of committees. Those committees that should remain in place throughout the year shall be designated as Standing Committees. These committees shall be established at the annual organization meeting. Other committees that are established from time to time for a specific purpose shall be designated as a Special Committee that will dissolve after their special mandate has been fulfilled.

1. All committees will be structured in accordance with the following format and shall only exercise powers as specifically assigned by the Board:
  - A. Name of the Committee
  - B. Standing Committee or Special Committee
