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## **POLICY SECTION 306: School/Program Evaluation**

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### **POLICY**

The Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education intends to promote, achieve, and maintain a high standard of program quality. School/Program evaluation is a necessary function of program operations. The aims of this system of evaluation are to measure the degree which a school/program is meeting its goals and to provide information which will be used in making decisions regarding modifications, expansion, or termination of programs.

### **GUIDELINES**

The following principles will serve as guidelines of proper evaluation:

- A. Program/school evaluation will be conducted in an atmosphere of trust, confidence, and support.
- B. Program/school evaluation will be conducted on a regular basis.
- C. Parent/Community feedback about school/program effectiveness will be sought and acknowledged.
- D. Employees in programs that are evaluated will have an opportunity to discuss the assessment of the program as part of the evaluation process.
- E. Written evaluation reports for the Board will be handled with due consideration for confidential material that may be included in these reports.
- F. School/program evaluation is an important component in decision-making particularly when program delivery modifications and resource allocation for such programs are under consideration.
