



POLICY SECTION 307: System Evaluation

POLICY

The Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education believes in the importance of educational system evaluation. The Board shall evaluate the effectiveness of the system and its utilization resources to the optimal benefit of the students within the community.

GUIDELINES

The Board will conduct a formal evaluation system and/or its component parts in order to ascertain:

1. the appropriateness and achievement of program objectives;
2. the degree to which the component parts of the system effectively interrelate;
3. the perception of the system among the various community stakeholders.

The result of system evaluation will be used to make decisions with respect to:

1. the enhancement, maintenance, modification or discontinuation of present fiscal, management and program objectives of the system; and
2. ways in which the objectives of the fiscal, management and program components can be attained in a more efficient manner.
 - Evaluation of the educational system or its component parts will be conducted on a regular basis as determined by the Board.
 - A comprehensive system evaluation or integration of component evaluation will be conducted once every 5 years.
 - The Board shall direct the comprehensive system evaluation through an evaluation team composed of internal and/or external personnel.
 - The terms of reference for the evaluation shall be approved of by the Board or as contained in policy. The terms of reference shall provide for descriptions and recommendations for improvement.
