



POLICY SECTION 416: DAMAGE OF BOARD PROPERTY

POLICY

The Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education believes it has a responsibility to ensure that its property is safeguarded from theft or damage as a result of carelessness or misconduct on the part of an employee. The property of the board is intended for educational purposes and loss of or damage to that property affects the ability of the Board to deliver educational programs and services.

GUIDELINES

School equipment and supplies:

1. A significant amount of the annual budget of the Board is designated for school supplies, instructional equipment, and curriculum resources. The Board holds its instructional staff, School Principals/Leaders and curriculum staff responsible for the optimal utilization of these valuable resources. Furthermore, all staff members are accountable for any misuse or loss of school resources.
2. The Principal/Leader shall ensure that all school equipment, supplies and materials are placed on the school inventory. The inventory shall be accounted for before the end of each school year and secured for the summer months. Any staff member failing to return assigned equipment or unused materials shall have the costs of said equipment or materials deducted from their final pay check.

Should equipment or curriculum resources assigned to a staff member become damaged, the staff member shall be responsible for the cost of repair or replacement
