



POLICY SECTION 502: Staff Ethics

POLICY

The Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education believes that in order for its educational programs to be effective, the Board requires employees of integrity, strong moral character and compassion. In order to promote these qualities, all employees of the Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education are expected to maintain the highest standards of professionalism at all times. These standards are exemplified by the following:

1. To always place the welfare of children first.
2. To always maintain just and courteous professional relationships with students, parents/guardians, staff members and other.
3. To always represent the Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education in a positive manner especially where the contributions of the school system to the community are recognized.
4. To refrain from using school contacts and privileges of their profession to promote partisan politics and/or sectarian religious views.

All employees are expected to set a good example for the optimal development of the students and conduct themselves in a manner appropriate for their profession. Further, all employees shall know and adhere to the policies of the Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education and the Mohawk Council of Akwasasne, and also must abide by the by-laws of the Mohawk Council of Akwasasne. Also, all employees shall adhere to the ethical standards as set by their licensing body.
