



POLICY SECTION 701: Community Information Program

POLICY

The Ahkwasahsne Mohawk Board of Education believes that if parents and community members are to maintain an interest in education, the Board must keep them informed about the issues, achievements, and programs operated by the Board. This requires regular utilization of local media and all other channels of communication available.

GUIDELINES

The Board and administration shall provide information to the community by:

1. Holding community meetings on a regular basis and making them open to the community.
2. Scheduling an annual general meeting within 90 days of receiving the annual financial audit report.
3. Requiring the schools to publish a school newsletter on a regular basis. The School Principal must approve the contents of school newsletter before distribution. Also, the School Principal should preview all information submitted to local media by school staff. Copies of newsletters and newspaper articles, etc. should be forwarded to the Board office.
4. Having regular open house programs for parents/guardians and members of the community.
5. Forwarding information about current and upcoming school events to all local media, the website and social media on a regular basis.
