POLICY

The Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education believes that community involvement and participation in our schools improves the quality of education for students. The Board recognizes parent committees as an avenue that facilitates activities for community involvement in education.

GUIDELINES

The formation of School Committees is encouraged with the following objectives in mind.

The list provides suggestions for Committees, but is not intended to reflect objectives that the Committee must achieve.

A school Committee may:

- a) Develop, improve and enhance effective communications between the school, community and the Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education.
- b) Assist Board members and administration by providing educational information to the community.
- c) Study and report on educational issues/problems in order to make recommendations to administration and/or the Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education.
