Important Covid-19 Pandemic Information: From March 2020 - October 1, 2020, NJ had a stay at home order; therefore students received the course curriculum remotely, using synchronous model; classes were not conducted using live instruction. From October 2020 - June 2021, students were on a rotating cohort model; some students rotated attending school in-person and then learned remotely based on cohorts. Throughout the year attendance options varied; 100% in person, virtual, or hybrid based on state health guidelines.
