- 1 Vice-President Whitcomb called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m.

- 3 Mr. Whitcomb opened the floor to the public for comments. Jahmal Cole, resident of Chatham and candidate for US Congress, (1st Congressional District of Illinois) and also runs the non-profit for My Block My Hood My City, introduced himself and explained what work he has done. He then provided additional information about him and his campaign. He stated he likes the things that BHS 228 are doing and would like to become more involved. He thanked the board and teachers for being superheroes. There being no additional comments, Mr. Whitcomb closed the floor to the public.
