- 3 Mrs. Resler opened the floor to the public for comments.

- 4 Dr. Sikora reported new teacher inductions were held last week and included informative sessions and administration, admin meeting was held the day before, buildings are being prepped to receive students, and next week will be a very busy week. Sports have also begun.
- 5 Dr. Goggins did not receive any questions regarding personnel recommendations. He informed the board that upon board approval next week, we are completely staffed. There is a need for some ancillary positions, such as paraprofessionals.
