LEA Plan for Use Of Funds

1. All school staff and any visitors to school and district buildings shall be required to wear face coverings unless health conditions prevent the individual from safely wearing a mask or the individual is under two years of age. Students are required to wear masks when physical distancing cannot be maintained or at times when they are in hallways or potentially interacting in close proximity with others.

The district HVAC systems do provide for a fresh air component. The district intends to ensure that fresh air is circulated in the classrooms to the extent practical.
