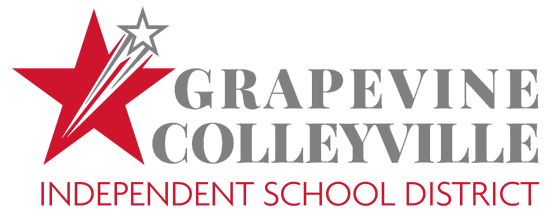

## Instructional Delivery

- Video viewed by female students only. Parents must opt in for students to participate.
- A district nurse responds to questions about the video.

## TEKS

Beginning in Grade 4, students learn about changes associated with adolescent development in the reproductive and sexual health strand. In subsequent grade levels, students identify the purpose of these changes and their role in fertilization and reproduction. Students learn the characteristics of healthy and unhealthy relationships and how to use communication and refusal skills to set personal boundaries in dating/romantic relationships. Students also identify how to respond to sexual harassment and abuse.

(20) Reproductive and sexual health--anatomy, puberty, and reproduction. The student identifies adolescent development. The student is expected to:

- (A) explain changes that occur in males and females during puberty and adolescent development; and
- (B) define the menstrual cycle.

## Overview of Program in GCISD

- Just Around the Corner - For Girls: Designed for younger students, this program is grounded in fact, sensitive to young feelings and reassuring about changes that are on the way. Younger elementary-level girls will appreciate this upbeat look at the changes of puberty. New narration and photography with lighthearted animated figures prepare girls for the momentous changes waiting "just around the corner."
- Topics covered include when to expect the onset of puberty, the physical and emotional changes of puberty, the maturation of the female reproductive system, and menstruation.
