

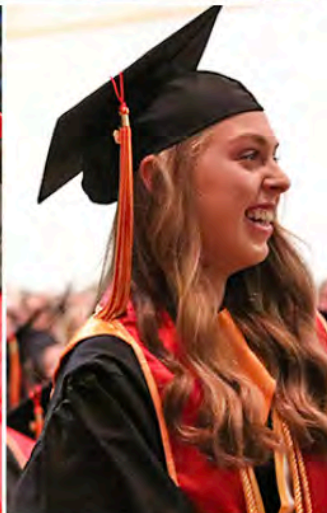
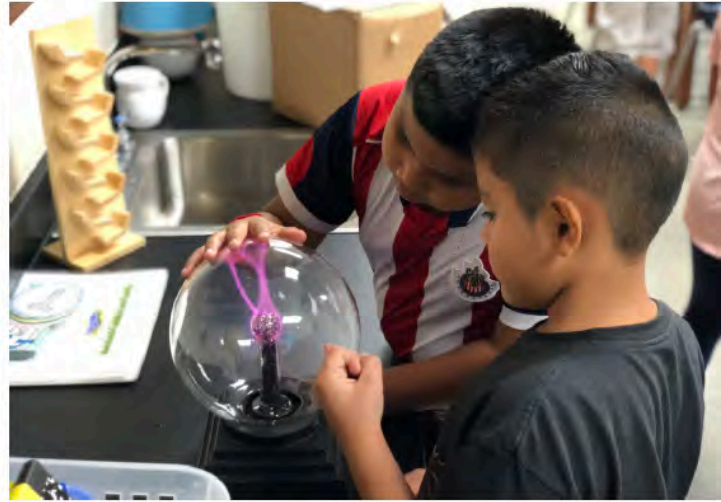

Bransford Elementary School is on the journey to becoming an **arts integrated campus**.

The **ASPIRE Academy** is designed to meet the needs of highly gifted students who require significant curricular modifications in elementary, middle and high school.

AVID (Advanced Via Individual Determination) has been implemented at all six traditional secondary campuses.

GCISD Collegiate Academy at Tarrant County College opened in 2014. Students can graduate in four years with a high school diploma as well as an associate degree.

Two-way **Dual Language** programs have been implemented on two elementary campuses.

Dove Elementary School has been approved as a candidate school for the **International Baccalaureate (IB) Primary Years Programme**, pursuing authorization as an IB World School.

iUniversity Prep is a tuition-free, virtual public school that offers choice for students that may not be able to attend classes daily, such as students preparing for the Olympics, whose parents travel extensively, or those with illnesses.

Timberline Elementary is a **Leader in Me Lighthouse** School. Students see themselves as leaders and practice the 7 Habits of Highly Effective People.

Bear Creek Elementary is in the **No Excuses University (NEU)** network of schools.

Cannon Elementary School: A **GCISD STEM School** integrates each of the content areas (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) into the regular curriculum.

The GCISD **Technology Education and Career Center (TECC)** allows students from both high schools to explore programs such as automotive technology, health careers, culinary arts, public safety, A/V production, business and more.

GCISD **Full-day Pre-K** has been implemented at 8 elementary schools across the district.
